

Instructions for election officials

Your job is to make sure voters move steadily through the polling place. This is important because the polling place needs to be orderly so voters get their ballot papers quickly and vote in private.

What you need to do:

- 1. Stand near the entrance to the polling place
- 2. As voters enter, ask them to wait in line until an issuing officer is free.
- 3. Direct each person to the next available issuing officer to collect their ballot paper.
